If you are interested in being part of the agape process for the upcoming walks, you may talk to me at our next gathering, which happens to be the picnic, or call me at 864-982-1672.

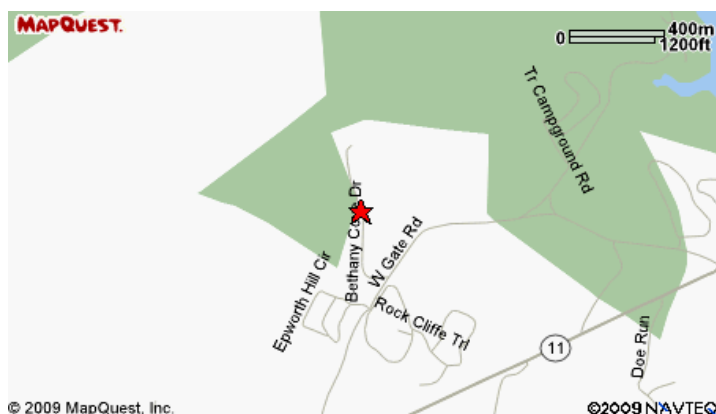
