Thank you to everyone who helped with the literature committee during the walks. It's a big job that could use a few extra helpers. Here are some areas that could use helpers:

- 1. Labeling the Agape envelopes with names and walk number then stuffing the agape envelopes with the Emmaus packet of papers, 4th day book, Upper Rooms, Emmaus brochure, and walk picture. (That's both weekends. If you are interested in volunteering for one or both, let the Literature chair know.)
- 2. Taking the walk picture on Friday mornings.
- 3. Setting out the Literature table on Saturday morning while the Grow through Study talk is going on. It takes about 10-15 minutes. If you live close to camp, it's a great way to help and it doesn't take up much time.
- 4. Put away the book table on the Sunday after closing of Men's Walk so that it's ready for the Women's Walk.
